

## Christmas Window Cookies

¾ c ..... Sugar  
1 c ..... Butter  
1 ea ..... egg  
1 tsp ..... Vanilla  
2½ c ..... Flour  
½ tsp ..... Salt

Hard candies (life savors or jolly ranchers work well)

1. Heat oven to 325°F.
2. Cream sugar and butter together.
3. Beat in the egg and vanilla.
4. Mix the flour and salt together and add into the mixture.
5. Refrigerate overnight.
6. Roll to ¼ inch thick on a floured board and cut with a cutter.
7. Place on a cookie sheet with foil.
8. Cut centers out with a knife or smaller cutter.
9. Crush candies and place in the center of each cookie.
10. Bake in oven for about 10 minutes.
11. Let completely cool before removing from foil.



This was a favorite cookie I used to make with my sisters and mom every year for Christmas. You can use any sugar or butter cookie recipe for these. I have even cheated by using Nestle's Sugar cookie Shapes.
